



Agricultural Internships in Germany - Your Opportunity for Professional Growth

The Schorlemer Foundation of the German Farmers' Association offers exciting internship opportunities for young agricultural professionals from the agricultural sector. Gain valuable practical experience on German farms while developing your professional and intercultural skills.

What we offer:

- Professional internships on German farms
- Duration: 3 to 12 months
- Counselling and support before, during and after your stay in Germany
- Accommodation and meals arrangements with host farms
- Compensation according to German internship regulations: minimum wage (13,90€/h gross) or pocket money (520€/month) - as of 2026
- Participation in our International Agricultural Seminar
- Assistance with visa procedures and insurance in respective country of origin

Costs:

- One-time placement fee of €400 for Schorlemer Foundation **plus** the fee charged by the partner organization in the respective country of origin
- Accommodation and meals may be charged by host farms in cases where minimum wage applies
- Travel costs and insurance to be covered by participants

Available Sectors:

An internship is possible in **mixed farming operations, dairy farming, cattle breeding, crop farming, pig farming, poultry farming, horticulture, viticulture and agritourism.**

Requirements:

- Age: 18-30 years
- Origin in one of our partner countries: Australia, Austria, Botswana, Burundi, Canada, Denmark, France, India, Ireland, Japan, Kenya, Malawi, Namibia, New Zealand, Sweden, Swiss, Spain, Tanzania, Thailand, Uganda, USA, Rwanda, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe as well as many countries in Latin America (please inquire)
- Either:
 - enrolled in an agricultural university course **OR**
 - completed training/studies in agriculture
- Theoretical knowledge and practical work experience in the required field of training
- Very good English skills (better: Basic German language skills) and strong motivation to learn German
- High motivation and interest in German agriculture

Special Note:

Students **who need to complete a mandatory internship or want to do an orientation internship of up to 3 months can typically be placed more quickly.** However, this is not a requirement for participation in the program.
